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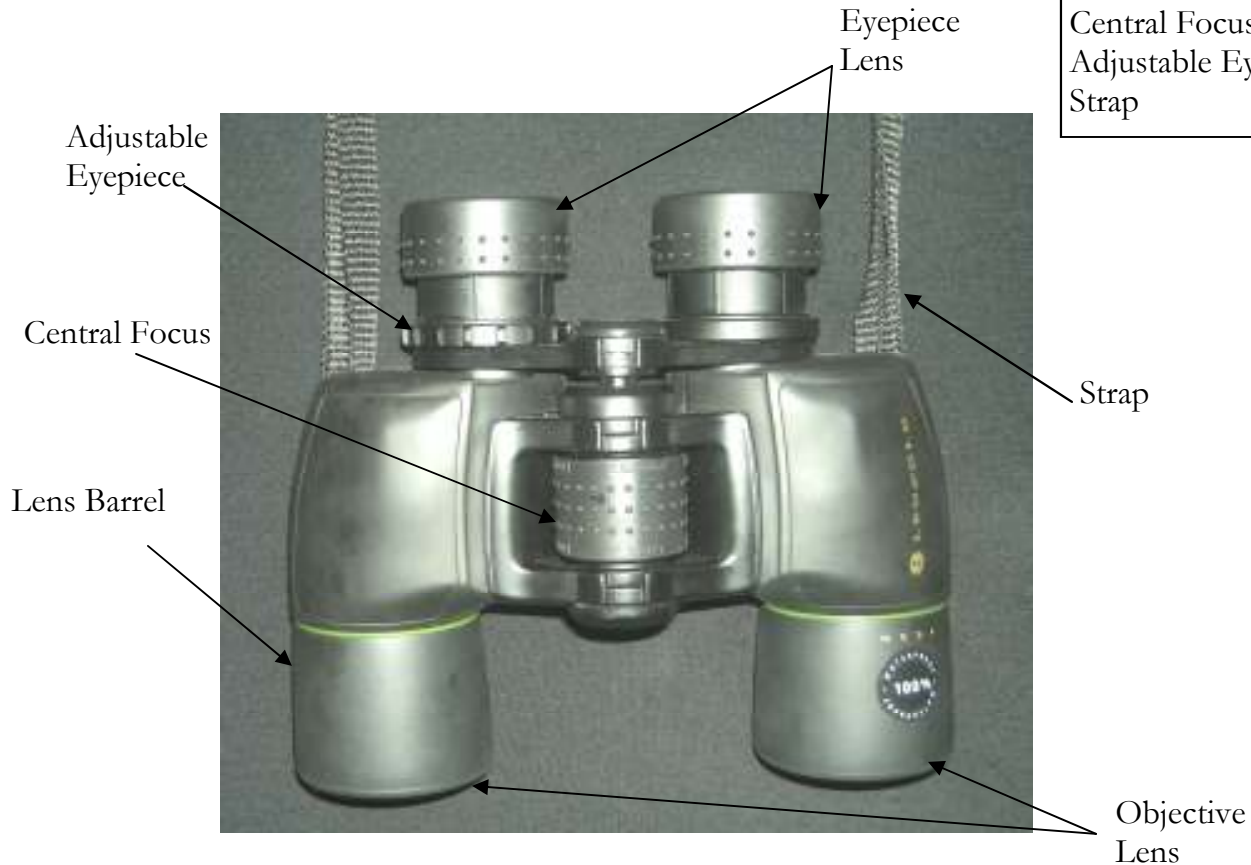

2. What are prisms and how do they work in binoculars?

Prisms are blocks of glass functioning as mirrors without reflecting back. Inside binoculars they function to turn the image right side up and allow us to view it properly from left to right.
